

COVID Safe Sporting and Games Equipment Information and Guidelines

Youthworks Conference Centres are committed to being COVID Safe and we have therefore implemented the following processes in relation to sporting and games equipment.

PRIOR TO YOUR STAY

- All sports and games equipment will be disinfected and sanitised

DURING YOUR STAY

- The games room and sports equipment containers will be locked, or equipment removed unless you, the group organiser, requests them to be opened. If you do wish them to be accessible to your group, please note:
- We ask that all people using the equipment wash or sanitise their hands before use
- We ask that all people using the equipment wash or sanitise their hands after use
- Any equipment that requires more than a brief touch e.g. pool cues, table tennis bats, air hockey bats, etc. should be limited to use by one person for the period of the 'game'.
- The equipment is not able to be sanitised by Youthworks staff during your stay.
- If your group chooses to disinfect and sanitise the equipment during your stay, please do not put any chemicals on any equipment which has material e.g. a pool table, as this will damage the equipment.

AFTER YOUR STAY

- All sporting and games equipment will be disinfected & sanitised, and or quarantined for at least 72 hours before its next use.

Your group is welcome to provide their own sports and games equipment. If your group does provide their own equipment the Youthworks games room and Youthworks sporting equipment containers will remain locked for the duration of your stay.
